

KenKor 360 respects your privacy and is committed to protecting Personal Information through the practices described in this Privacy Notice ("Notice"). This Notice explains the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit kenkor360.com (the "Website") or use related services (collectively, the "Services"), how we collect, use, retain, protect, and disclose that information, and the choices available to you.

This Notice applies between you ("User," "you," or "your") and KenKor 360 ("KenKor 360," "we," "us," or "our"). If you access or use the Website or Services on behalf of a business or other legal entity, you represent that you have authority to act for that entity. By accessing or using the Website or Services, you acknowledge that you have read and understood this Notice. This Notice does not apply to organizations we do not own or control or to individuals we do not employ or manage.

### **Automatic collection of information**

When you open the Website, our servers automatically record information that your browser sends. This data may include information such as your device's IP address, browser type, and version, operating system type and version, language preferences or the webpage you were visiting before you came to the Website and Services, pages of the Website and Services that you visit, the time spent on those pages, information you search for on the Website, access times and dates, and other statistics.

Information collected automatically is used only to identify potential cases of abuse and establish statistical information regarding the usage and traffic of the Website and Services. This statistical information is not otherwise aggregated in such a way that would identify any particular User of the system.

### **Collection of personal information**

You may access and use many parts of the Website and Services without identifying yourself. If you choose to use certain features, submit an inquiry, or request Services, you may be asked to provide Personal Information, such as your name, organization, telephone number, or other information relevant to your request.

We receive and store any information you knowingly provide to us when you fill any forms on the Website. When required, this information may include the following:

- Contact and business information, such as your name, organization, telephone number, and preferred method of contact.
- Information you include in website forms, inquiries, or service requests.
- Device and approximate location data made available through your browser or device settings.

You can choose not to provide us with your Personal Information, but then you may not be able to take advantage of some of the features on the Website. Users who are uncertain about what information is mandatory are welcome to contact us.

### **Privacy of children**

We do not knowingly collect any Personal Information from children under the age of 18. If you are under the age of 18, please do not submit any Personal Information through the Website and Services. If you have reason to believe that a child under the age of 18 has provided Personal Information to us through

the Website and Services, please contact us to request that we delete that child's Personal Information from our Services.

We encourage parents and legal guardians to monitor their children's Internet usage and to help enforce this Policy by instructing their children never to provide Personal Information through the Website and Services without their permission. We also ask that all parents and legal guardians overseeing the care of children take the necessary precautions to ensure that their children are instructed to never give out Personal Information when online without their permission.

### **Use and processing of collected information**

We act as a data controller and a data processor when handling Personal Information, unless we have entered into a data processing agreement with you in which case you would be the data controller and we would be the data processor.

Our role may also differ depending on the specific situation involving Personal Information. We act in the capacity of a data controller when we ask you to submit your Personal Information that is necessary to ensure your access and use of the Website and Services. In such instances, we are a data controller because we determine the purposes and means of the processing of Personal Information.

We act in the capacity of a data processor in situations when you submit Personal Information through the Website and Services. We do not own, control, or make decisions about the submitted Personal Information, and such Personal Information is processed only in accordance with your instructions. In such instances, the User providing Personal Information acts as a data controller.

In order to make the Website and Services available to you, or to meet a legal obligation, we may need to collect and use certain Personal Information. If you do not provide the information that we request, we may not be able to provide you with the requested products or services. Any of the information we collect from you may be used for the following purposes:

- Send administrative information
- Request user feedback
- Improve user experience
- Run and operate the Website and Services

Processing your Personal Information depends on how you interact with the Website and Services, where you are located in the world and if one of the following applies: (i) you have given your consent for one or more specific purposes; (ii) provision of information is necessary for the performance of an agreement with you and/or for any pre-contractual obligations thereof; (iii) processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which you are subject; (iv) processing is related to a task that is carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in us; (v) processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by us or by a third party.

Note that under some legislations we may be allowed to process information until you object to such processing by opting out, without having to rely on consent or any other of the legal bases. In any case, we will be happy to clarify the specific legal basis that applies to the processing, and in particular whether the provision of Personal Information is a statutory or contractual requirement, or a requirement necessary to enter into a contract.

## **Disclosure of information**

We do not sell Personal Information. We may disclose Personal Information to service providers and professional advisors that support our Website, business operations, security, or legal compliance, but only as reasonably necessary for those purposes and subject to appropriate confidentiality obligations. We may also disclose information at your direction or with your consent.

We may also disclose Personal Information when required or permitted by law, including to comply with legal process or governmental requests, protect our rights, property, or safety or that of others, investigate suspected fraud or misuse, enforce agreements, or support a business transaction such as a merger, reorganization, or transfer of assets.

## **Retention of information**

We will retain and use your Personal Information for the period necessary to enforce our agreements, resolve disputes, and unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law up to a maximum of 60 months.

We may use any aggregated data derived from or incorporating your Personal Information after you update or delete it, but not in a manner that would identify you personally. Once the retention period expires, Personal Information shall be deleted. Therefore, the right to access, the right to erasure, the right to rectification, and the right to data portability cannot be enforced after the expiration of the retention period.

## **Cookies**

The Website may use cookies and similar technologies to support essential functions, remember preferences, improve performance, maintain security, and understand Website usage. Cookies are small text files stored on your device by your browser. They cannot run programs or deliver viruses.

You can manage cookies through your browser settings and, when available, the Website's cookie controls. Blocking certain cookies may affect Website functionality. Where required by applicable law, we will request consent before using nonessential cookies.

## **Do Not Track signals**

Some browsers and devices provide privacy preference signals, including Do Not Track or Global Privacy Control. Because standards and legal requirements continue to evolve, our response may depend on the signal, browser, jurisdiction, and applicable law. We will honor legally recognized signals where required.

## **Links to other resources**

The Website and Services may contain links to other resources that are not owned or controlled by us. Please be aware that we are not responsible for the privacy practices of such other resources or third parties. We encourage you to be aware when you leave the Website and Services and to read the privacy statements of each and every resource that may collect Personal Information.

## **Information security**

We secure information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. We maintain reasonable administrative, technical, and

physical safeguards in an effort to protect against unauthorized access, use, modification, and disclosure of Personal Information in our control and custody. However, no data transmission over the Internet or wireless network can be guaranteed.

Therefore, while we strive to protect your Personal Information, you acknowledge that (i) there are security and privacy limitations of the Internet which are beyond our control; (ii) the security, integrity, and privacy of any and all information and data exchanged between you and the Website and Services cannot be guaranteed; and (iii) any such information and data may be viewed or tampered with in transit by a third party, despite best efforts.

Mobile telephone information, text message opt-in data, and consent records will not be sold or shared with third parties or affiliates for their independent marketing or promotional purposes. We may use service providers to deliver communications or support related functions, subject to contractual restrictions and applicable law.

### **Data breach**

In the event we become aware that the security of the Website and Services has been compromised or Users' Personal Information has been disclosed to unrelated third parties as a result of external activity, including, but not limited to, security attacks or fraud, we reserve the right to take reasonably appropriate measures, including, but not limited to, investigation and reporting, as well as notification to and cooperation with law enforcement authorities. In the event of a data breach, we will make reasonable efforts to notify affected individuals if we believe that there is a reasonable risk of harm to the User as a result of the breach or if notice is otherwise required by law. When we do, we will post a notice on the Website.

### **Changes and amendments**

We may update this Notice from time to time. When we do, we will revise the effective date below and post the updated Notice on the Website. If a change materially affects how we handle Personal Information, we may provide additional notice through the Website or another appropriate channel.

An updated version of this Policy will be effective immediately upon the posting of the revised Policy unless otherwise specified. Your continued use of the Website and Services after the effective date of the revised Policy (or such other act specified at that time) will constitute your consent to those changes. However, we will not, without your consent, use your Personal Information in a manner materially different than what was stated at the time your Personal Information was collected.

### **Your choices and acknowledgment**

By using the Website and Services, you acknowledge that you have reviewed this Notice. Where consent is required for a particular processing activity, we will request it separately. You may exercise available privacy choices as described in this Notice and under applicable law.

### **Contact and privacy requests**

To ask a question, raise a concern, submit a complaint, or exercise an applicable privacy right, use the contact or privacy request form available on [kenkor360.com](http://kenkor360.com). Please provide enough detail for us to understand and verify your request. Do not submit sensitive Personal Information unless specifically requested.

We will review verified requests and respond within the period required by applicable law. We may need additional information to confirm your identity or authority before completing a request.
